The Yellowstone Regional Airport Authority will host an Airport Master Plan Update Open House on Tuesday June 9, from 6-7pm in the Duggleby Room at Yellowstone Regional Airport located at 2101 Roger Sedam Drive in Cody, WY.

The purpose of the Public Open House to share the proposed Master Plan and solicit public comment from the community. This event is intended to give the public an opportunity to learn about the positive changes taking place and some of the potential improvements that are being considered as part of the airport's master planning process.

Interested residents are encouraged to attend and may come and go as convenient. There is no formal presentation scheduled. Representatives from the airport staff and the consultant team will be available to answer questions and receive comments.

The Airport's Master Plan is a comprehensive study that will describe proposed short, medium and long-term improvements needed to meet future aviation demand and other airport needs. Funding for the Master Plan Update study includes grants from the Federal Aviation Administration and the Aeronautics Division of the Wyoming Department of Transportation. The primary goal of the Airport Master Plan Update is to prepare a living document that will serve as the airport's official planning guide for capital expenditures for the next twenty years.
